## The Algilez Phrase Book

This Phrase Book contains both a variety of phrases such that a tourist might need (e.g. travelling and booking into hotels etc) plus additional material that will deal with other aspects of day to day living.

As well as the phrases themselves, the intention is to try and cover as many as possible of the grammatical and tense uses that are likely to regularly occur in the language.

### Translations:

As is the case with most translations, the Algilez version may appear to say something slightly different to the English version but this is really just a case of translating the meaning rather than the words themselves.

The Algilez translations also sometimes include alternatives. The fuller ones often being included to help understand the full response, the shorter ones being perfectly acceptable if the context and meaning are clear. There are often several alternative ways of saying the same thing and these are also included.

### Pronunciation:

Consonants:- 'c' is pronounced 'ch' (as in cheddar); 'x' is pronounced 'sh' (as in shed); 'q' is pronounced 'th' (as in three). 'g' as in 'get', 'j' as in 'jet', 'y' as in 'yet'. All others pronounced as in English.

Vowels:- 'ä' as in fär, 'ø' as in ført, 'a' as in 'cat', 'e' as in 'bet', 'i' as in 'feel', 'o' as in 'pop', 'u' as in 'pool'.
