Supplementary Regulations

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Cambridge Car Club will promote a Clubsport Car Trial, THE ROGER HOLMES MEMORIAL TRIAL. On Sunday 20th January 2008, at Harlton, Nr Cambridge.

2. JURISDICTION

The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd 2008., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. AUTHORISATION

MSA Permit Number 44036 has been issued.

4. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all fully elected members of Cambridge Car Club, West Suffolk Motor Club, Kings Lynn & D.M.C., Cambridge University Auto Club, Falcon Motor Club and Eastern Counties Motor Club..

All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.

Competition membership of Cambridge Car Club is available at a subscription of £5.00

A New Comer entry is available for competitors who do not belong to any Car Club. The subscription includes membership to the Cambridge Car Club and Entry to the ROGER HOLMES MEMORIAL TRIAL.

5. PROGRAMME

Sunday 20th January 2008 at Clay Pit Hill, Harlton, Nr. Cambridge.

Any competitor not signed on by 10.20 may be excluded or fined £10.00 at C. of C. discretion.

6. FORMAT

Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 15 sections on private land.

7. CLASSES (all as J86 to J90)

1. Unballasted two wheel drive production saloon cars under 12 years old driven to the event..

2. All other front wheel drive production saloon cars not eligible for class 1.

3. Rear wheel drive production cars not eligible for class 1.

4. Modified production cars and Kit Cars as J89

5. Unballasted 4WD production saloon cars of monocoque driven to the event as J90.

Tyre pressures for each class will be issued on the day.

Any car with a torque-biasing differential or any other form of traction control will have tyre pressures set 4psi above the relevant class pressures

Any car with an overall length of 166 inches or more may reduce tyre pressures by not more than 4psi subject to a minimum pressure of 10 psi.

(a) TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

All vehicles must comply with RACMSA Technical Regulations.

8. AWARDS

Awards will be presented as follows: -

No competitor may win more than one award. All awards will be presented at the finish after the results are declared final, and all award winners must attend to collect them.

All named awards remain the property of Cambridge Car Club Ltd. And must be returned to the club after 11 months or one month before the next Cambridge Car Club Hallen Trophy Trial, whichever is sooner. ALL other awards are perpetual.

9. ENTRY LIST

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations, closes at the lower entry fee on 11th January 2008, and closes finally on 20th January 2008 at 10.00 hrs.

11. ENTRIES

The maximum entry for the meeting is 50 plus 5 reserves. The minimum is 12. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected on a first come first served basis. Entry fees may be refunded IN FULL upon notification in writing to the Entries Secretary of withdrawal before the 20th January 2008.

13. RESULTS

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event (B13.1.b). Printed result sheets will be available at the finish. Results will be posted during the week following the event.

14. PROTESTS

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with Section C(d)

15. IDENTIFICATION

Competitors will be identified by a scorecard.

16. PENALTIES

Marking and penalties will be as J37 of the MSA General Regulations 2008.

In addition driving at excessive speed on the event field or causing damage to the perimeter fence carries a penalty of 24 points for the first offence and exclusion for the second offence.

17. GENERAL REGULATIONS

A43. Vehicles may be double driven. Competitors may enter twice but only in vehicles eligible in different classes & that such an entry does not prevent a reserve entry running. All other GR's of the MSA apply as written

18. THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT.

The organisers reserve the right, in the event of wet weather that is likely to make the venue very slippery, to postpone the event to a later date or to shorten the event. This is to ensure the future availability of the venue.
