Principles of the Family Law Society

- There should be a presumption of both parents being equal, with parents invited to concede parenting time as opposed to the adversarial contest of fighting to gain parenting time.
- There should be a domicile rule that prevents a parent from moving away with their child/ren, when such a move would hinder the other parent's ability to fulfil their role as a parent.
- The police, through the normal legal process, should investigate accusations against the other parent. To make unfounded accusations in a closed courtroom is not fair.
