The Department of Pharmacology, Therapeutics and Toxicology offers the following courses that provide an excellent opportunity to address learning needs in the area of medical toxicology as part of the annual appraisal and continuing professional development cycle.

DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL TOXICOLOGY

(Commencing 25 September 2006)

This Diploma programme is designed for doctors, pharmacists and other scientists working (or hoping to work) in the pharmaceutical or chemical industry, regulatory bodies or health service and who wish to develop a broad understanding of the principles underlying medical toxicology. The Diploma course consists of six five-week modules of distance-learning material written by experts in the field. During the course there will be an opportunity to attend a three day course organised by the National Poisons Information Service (Cardiff Centre) to be held on 13/14/15 November 2006 in Cardiff. Continual assessment and a final examination lead to the Diploma in Medical Toxicology in 2006.

A limited number of candidates who satisfactorily complete the Diploma course may be invited to progress to an MSc in the second year.

Course fee for Diploma 2006/2007: £2,423 (subject to confirmation and which includes the tuition fee for the three day course)

CERTIFICATE IN MEDICAL TOXICOLOGY

(Commencing 2 October 2005)

The Certificate in Medical Toxicology is designed for medical personnel, specifically clinical pharmacologists in training, specialist registrars in other disciplines and those intending to join, or who are already members of, the pharmaceutical industry. It is also suitable for those seeking a career in governmental regulatory bodies. The material consists of five three-part modules of material similar to the Diploma in Medical Toxicology and is similarly assessed. Candidates who satisfactorily complete the Certificate course may be eligible to study for the Diploma. There is also an opportunity for candidates on this course to attend the three day course organised by the National Poisons Information Service (Cardiff Centre) referred to above.

Course fee for Certificate 2006/2007: £1,584 (which is subject to confirmation and which includes the three day course).
