

THE MADAGASCAR PROJECT

The Vision

The vision is to build links with YWAM Tana in Madagascar and serve them by working towards meeting their needs. This involves sending a team out there to aid with skills and man power, taking financial help & hopefully other resources to help tackle poverty. For the year 2008, we want to go out for the first 3 weeks of July. The mission is to bless the community in anyway we can.



Faly & his family

We met a man called Faly, from YWAM Madagascar at the start of 2007 and his story captured us. He had travelled from a deprived community where there was no running water, no electricity, and very basic education and health facilities. We really felt God was tugging our hearts in the direction of Madagascar. So we quickly put together a plan to get to Madagascar within 3 months. We raised approx. £2100 which would have covered travelling expenses. Unfortunately, because of visa complications we weren't able to go. Instead we gave £1400 to Faly. The plan was to save the remaining £700 to try again this year, 2008.

2008 - Mission: Tana

This year we're planning a three week trip to "House of Nations", the YWAM base just outside Antananarivo. We'll be ideally a team of 6, Zoe, Ross and four others. Having spoken to Faly, at YWAM Tana, we have highlighted two high priority projects to work on, along with a few smaller projects where our help would be welcomed.

What projects will you be working on?

The first of the two main projects, would be a secondary school building, which needs completing and making ready for use. The second project would be a high school building including their first computer school, to house computers donated by [Mission World Aid](#).

What will it all cost?

We have a guide of £1000 per person for the three weeks. This would cover flights, accomodation, food, injections & anti-malarial medicines. The budget given to us by House of Nations for the two main projects is £7000. This would cover all materials for roofing, walls, windows and other miscellaneous building materials. That gives a total approximate cost of £13000, to be raised over the next 6 months.

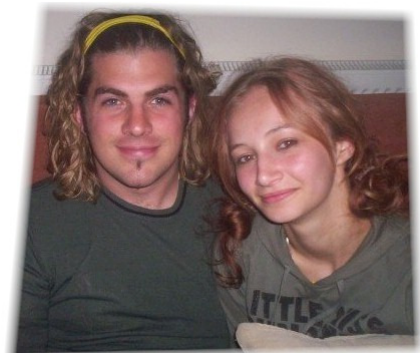
Our Partners
