19/00	<p>APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE</p> <p>Apologies were received from Cllrs James Baird, Mrs Oakley and Mr Wotherspoon</p>	
20/00	<p>MATTERS OF URGENCY NOT ON THE AGENDA</p> <p>(a) Activities at Bailiffscourt Hotel</p> <p>Following a complaint by a resident about noise from the Hotel outward bound activities members agreed to visit the area when such an event was taking place.</p> <p>(b) Rubble on Ford Airfield</p> <p>Cllr Mrs Rudd agreed to approach SWS Ltd about the pile of rubble by the footpath on the airfield which posed a hazard to children.</p>	<p>Clerk</p> <p>Mrs Rudd</p>
21/00	<p>MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 6 JUNE 2000</p> <p>The Minutes of the meeting of 6 June 2000 were confirmed and signed by the Chairman as a true record.</p>	
22/00	<p>ADMINISTRATION</p> <p>(a) Village Newsletter</p> <p>The Vice Chairman reported that there had been a good response to this idea and that the matter was progressing well.</p> <p>(b) Question and Answer Session</p> <p>It was agreed that the Vice Chairman and Cllr Forster should be the parish representatives on the Question and Answer panel on 25 October.</p> <p>(c) Safety of Children in Clymping</p> <p>The Parish Council heard an address from the police about this and other related issues of policing in the area and it was confirmed that there was a police officer whose task was to monitor sex offenders in the area.</p>	
23/00	<p>PLANNING</p> <p>(a) CM 17/00 Additional Library at School</p> <p>(b) CM18/00 Church House, Church Lane</p> <p>(c) CM19/00 Elmside, Clymping Street</p> <p>(d) CM21/00 Brookpit Cottage dormer windows</p> <p>Members had no objection to these proposals.</p> <p>(e) 15/00 Twizzlewig</p> <p>Members felt that they wanted more traditional development in the area, especially when it fronted Horsemere Green Lane so that it would match the other properties in the area. It was also agreed to ask Arun DC to a meeting</p>	Clerk

of the Parish Council to discuss general strategy in the area.

(f) CM23/00 Baird Farm Shop (John and Claire Baird left the meeting when this item was discussed)

Since this site was south of the A259 and in an area where there were development restrictions they felt that the overall development changed the character of the area too much but would not oppose a basic single storey extension to the side of the property.

(g) CM25/00 Fordacres

Members objected to this proposal since they felt there was a need to keep the appearance of the property as originally planned and not to reduce it to a cheaper option.

(b) Sewage in Clymping

Cllr Mrs Shorrock reported that sewage from Orchard Way had come up in the properties at the junction of Horsemere Green Lane and Yapton Road and it was agreed to raise this with SWS Ltd
