

	<p>(a) Planning Lists 32-37 (Cllr Biss was not present at the meeting while these items were discussed) CM18/04 Village Hall Members had no objection to the extension to the village hall despite earlier reservations about the flat roof. They felt that the extension, with toilets for the disabled, was desperately needed and even with grants and fun-raising it would be impossible in such a small village, to raise sufficient funds for an extension with a raised roof and that it would be a challenge just to raise the funds for the essential extension alone. However, members did feel that it should be possible to seek a quotation for the raised roof to see if the extra money might be raised and Cllr. Baird pointed out that there were many potential sources of grant money that could be investigated, once the required sum was known.</p> <p>CM20/04 Amberley Court Members had no objection to this proposal.</p> <p>Application under the Caravan Sites Act (Cllr Bye declared an interest in this item and took no part in its discussion) Members had no objection to the application for a new sewage plant for Clymping Park provided it was adequately screened from the main road and from residences in the park.</p>
