

93/04	<p>PLANNING</p> <p>(a) Planning Lists 11-15 (Cllr Biss took no part in this item and Mrs Edge in application CM4/05) CM4/05 Extension to 3 Kents Cottages Members felt that the amendment to the balcony did not alter the fact that this was out of keeping and continued to maintain their objection to the application.</p> <p>CM7/05 Church Farm Cottage Members had no objection to the house extension but the felt the large detached garage with dormer windows placed up against the neighbouring fence was unnecessary. Members felt the owners should resubmit plans for a less intrusive garage with a plain roof with lower pitch. Applications such as these were felt to be thinly disguised attempts at installing extra bedrooms at a later date.</p> <p>(b) SWS Treatment Works – appeal against smell notice Members noted the inquiry on 17 May at Fontwell.</p>	
94/04	<p>HIGHWAYS</p> <p>(a) Transport Group Cllr Mrs Edge reported that there had still been no positive proposals concerning the access to Clymping Park but that pressure was being applied by her. Cllr Taylor said that he was having difficulty contacting the County Engineer about Church Lane and so it was difficult to know what was being planned. All members discussed the suggestion of the Ford Enterprise Hub and Cllr Tyrrell reported that the Transport group were preparing a response to the argument.</p> <p>(b) Advertising signs Cllr Tyrrell reported that display of signs is a planning issue and read a draft letter which he felt should be sent to the owners of the Rudford Estate. Members agreed that Arun Council be asked to write the letter in the first instance and that Cllr Biss should report back on progress.</p> <p>(c) Viridor Cllr Tyrrell reported that Viridor was preparing contingency plans to send recyclables to China via Southampton and Felixstowe. Apparently some form of traffic optimisation study was being done to take account of environmental issues and Burgess Hill WTS was being scrutinised as a possible MRF site.</p>	Biss
