112/05	<b>COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC</b> There was a discussion about gypsies at the bottom of Clymping Street.	
113/05	<b>COMMENTS FROM COUNTY COUNCILLOR</b> Cllr Mrs Freeman reported on the progress of the Viridor scheme.	
114/05	<b>ADMINISTRATION</b> (a) Play Area Cllr Haymes (ADC) agreed to chase Arun DC lawyers about the preparation of the formal agreement for the play area  (b) Village Hall Cllr Bye reported that they had received substantial grants recently which meant that work could start on phase one of the restoration shortly.  (c) Parish Council Website It was agreed that the Clerk should contact Arun DC about supporting the parish website.  (d) Parish Council Procedures Cllr Tyrrell reported that the proposal was to have three sub-groups – Planning, Transport and Environment and members would seek full council approval before deciding policy issues. It was agreed to invite a representative of SALC to a future meeting to discuss procedures.	
115/05	<b>FINANCE</b> (a) Payment of Accounts It was agreed to pay the following accounts: SALC (Subscription) £204.02 Cornhill (Insurance) £457.13 Vektra (newsletter) £120.00 Vektra (newsletter for Sep 05) £115.20  (b) Annual Accounts The Clerk outlined the annual accounts and explained that there was a balance of £14,000 being carried forward.	

116/05	<p><b>PLANNING</b></p> <p>(a) Planning Lists 9-15 F/17/05 Houses opposite Clymping Church Members ratified a letter already sent to Arun DC objecting to the proposal and explaining that there was no demonstrable need for affordable housing in the area and that the environmental report contained several errors.</p> <p>F04/06 and F05/06 It was agreed that the Clerk would get details of both these applications for members</p> <p>(b) Parish Plan It was agreed that this item be deferred for a while until a basic outline of the plan had been worked up to show residents.</p>	
117/05	<p><b>HIGHWAYS</b></p> <p>(a) Transport Group The following matters were particularly highlighted: VAS Sign – Cllr Taylor reported that the one by Ferry Road still needed some adjustment and he would speak to Mr Mander about it. The one near the Oystercatcher was still in the pipeline. Village Feedback – Cllr Tyrrell asked that the Newsletter ask for feedback from the parish about the road improvements so far. Viridor – It was agreed Cllr Tyrrell and Cllr Taylor would represent the council at the next meeting about the Viridor proposals and that they would lobby for more works at the Oystercatcher instead of the existing proposals of Viridor.</p> <p>(b) Brownfield Status of Viridor Site An email from Arun DC explaining why they thought this site was a brownfield one was noted.</p> <p>(c) Visibility out of Horsemere Green Lane Cllr Taylor reported that improvements to the visibility here were under consideration by WSCC.</p> <p>(d) South Coast Skips It was decided not to pursue the question of traffic movements for the moment.</p>	
118/05	<p><b>ENVIRONMENT</b></p> <p>(a) Clymping Gap Cllr Biss reported that at the latest meeting the police identified three problems in the area – raves, fly tipping and indecency. Fly tippers were being prosecuted and a raves officer contact had been established. It was also hoped that signs with the police number would be put on the beach so people could ring if they saw a rave being set up.</p>
