Diving

The Northern or stern end is the best preserved, although it is debatable if it truly is the stern as the A-1 phoenix units used a “Noah s ark” configuration at both ends. The “Eastern wall” to the east of the stern is the best preserved of the whole site. Here the wall towers up and is topped by two towing bollards. The Southern or Bow end is almost totally collapsed and barely recognisable

Max Depth: 11 metres, usually plenty of marine life probably one of the best shallow dive sites on the south coast.
