There had been talk of him moving to the vacant First Team Coach's role but when Tommy Craig arrived this was clearly no longer on. Danny ended up making 33 appearances this season and left at the end of the season without any fanfare - a harsh oversight for a player and captain that had devoted his playing career to the club.
