Points for this Season

- 1) A League win was 2 pts and a draw 1 pt.
- 2) The League as seen above was constituted of 10 teams with 1 relegation of the bottom team and promotion of the top team in Division 1 at the end of the season
- 3) No stats are available for sendings off
- 4) No squad numbers were given this season
- 5) 2 substitutions were allowed per game in SPL games. A GK sub was generally not available.
- 6) Progression. Youths could be signed on an S-Form as young as 13; D-Forms were then generally signed which was an undertaking that the young player would sign for the club on leaving full time school education. Progression was usually part-time onto the Groundstaff as a young apprentice followed by full time as an apprentice and playing for the Reserve League West or for Giffnock North Amateur Athletic Club with which there was an arrangement
- 7) In tandem with the above scheme, the Celtic Boys Club ran teams from U12 to U16 and this was the main route of progression to the senior team. Those Youths signed on S and D Forms commonly continued to play for the Boys Club though at times they might continue with their original boys club before joining the main club full time.
- 8) Two Reserve Leagues ran - The Premier Reserve League and Reserve League West - the latter was predominantly a Youth League.
- 9) The SFA points limit for the first suspension was 10 points
- 10) In the Fixtures and Stats tab a starting players shorts number is given. If a player was substituted the sub is given the same number on the sheet so that it is possible to see who replaced who.
