Generally was inconsistent, and ill disciplined and prone to weight gain; he put in a transfer request 13/3/91 which was accepted and the latter part of the season was spent waiting for clubs to come in for him broken by a runout and goal in the last game of the season; Post-season, after McNeill was sacked Tommy Craig took him off the transfer list on 3/6/91. Subsequently on loan '94-'95 at Leicester. Retired after a horrendous car crash. Recently seen about and taken to the drink in a big way and weighing in around the 20 stone mark. A sad reflection on the way ex-players tend to be treated from not that distant past.

Played for Strathclyde Police team after leaving St Mirren to join Strathclyde's finest.

Almost a complete lack of opportunity at Celtic and never bedded into the team playing most of his time for the Reserves where he found his level and did well; transfer listed as of 18/3/91 but survived McNeill's sacking at the end of the season to see Brady arrive. Subsequently broke a leg whilst playing 8/4/92 whilst transfer listed; 10 appearances gave 0 goals; Transferred to Swansea City by Brady. Now works as a car salesman in Croydon and is manager of non-league Bishop's Stortford.

Still played and gave all saying he would honour his contract, though his lawyer was threatening to freeze Celtic's bank accounts. On the 19/12/90 he requested a transfer which was turned down by the Board and manager. However having settled the case out of court on 30/4/91 his continuance appeared to be more on the fans behalf than the Club's. He was linked to moves to Chelsea as early as late November '90 and this interest continued from Chelsea and, late in the season from West Ham. Was voted Players Player of the Year at the end of the season. With the season over though the transfer request was granted on 8/7/91 to Chelsea for £1.4m; 66 appearances gave 5 goals; retired from the professional game May '94 as a result of a cruciate injury sustained against Dean Saunders w

Had some time in '00 with Paramatta Power in Australia after ripping up his contract w Dundee Utd. Summer 00 signed a deal with Raith Rovers after being clubless for a while. 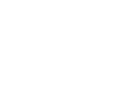
