Subsequently re-signed next season; awarded an MBE in the '97 New Years Honours list; 96/97 was his last season before retiring on 16/5/97 due to the wear and tear of injury - an ankle injury(stress fracture) finally putting pay to continuing playing. Subsequently did the Bosman walk to Monaco 1/8/96 was subject to an infamous Bunnet broadside with m'learned friends all to no avail (Monaco not part of EC etc); went to Everton on 1/8/98 for 2.5 million; 14/7/00 went on a free to Fulham; still at Fulham but less used; recently seen in the pre-season friendly for them at Parkhead.
