Originally a trainee at Rangers Boys Club, he broke a leg and was farmed out to East Sterling; he learnt his trade with East Fife(23/12/82 - 20/3/87) where he came to notice of the major clubs; went on to Falkirk from whence he was purchased by Brady in his first season as manager; Subsequently was Tommy Burns first choice keeper till succeeded by Stewart Kerr; then had loan periods w Stoke and St Mirren(1 week) before going to Kilmarnock where he has been the mainstay GK. 101 Celtic appearances.

He started well but by the second Old Firm game he found himself in the Reserves and failed to turn up for a game citing family problems down south. This was Payton's real bugbear. However the re-appearance of McAvennie provided the front man he needed to play off of and he ended the season as highest scorer with 15 goals. Subsequently became the first of Macari's transfers out. 20 goals in 46 appearances before "domestic problems forced a return down south on 24/11/93 to Barnsley where he went on to become a serious striker, followed by a return to his roots w Burnley.
