An exceptionally complicated season full of issues, from the resignation of Liam Brady and his team, the installation of Macari and his team, the pursuit of Cambuslang, Celts for Change and the supporters boycott, the total demise of the Club, the reappearance of Brian Dempsey, the takeover by Fergus McCann and his backers and finally the dismissal of Macari.
