

The Board and Backroom

The season saw Fergus McCann consolidate his holding with the share flotation and then the removal of the remains of the Old Board and the institution of the new. The old stadium was knocked down on 3 sides and the new North Stand started to rise whilst the Home games were played at soul-less Hampden. In the close season Macari was sacked and there then followed a long court case for Unfair Dismissal which Macari eventually lost. The SFA weighed in upholding the £100k fine for "tapping" Burns as well as being threatened with a 10k fine if they played without numbers on the back of the shirt. All these were appealed by McCann. Oh....and the start of a battle of wills between McCann and Farry at the SFA.
