Clearly did not relish his return to the Reserves and when offered a senior contract and first team role by Dundee Utd. he joined them on 4/11/95 for £150k, against Burns wishes but with his understanding. During his time at Celtic he won 4 Scotland U21 caps.; Presently with Falkirk against whom he debuted for Celtic and restarted his career this season.  |

Must have seen the competition coming for centre half when the Club bought Stubbs at the end of the season and Mackay and O'Neil available. Subsequently sold 1/11/97 to Hibs. After captaining Hibs for three seasons was picked up by Dalziel as club captain at Ayr on a Bosman. Remaindered by Dalziel last season and now back playing for Falkirk.   |

Burns dropped him after making 5 appearances and instigated a fitness programme to regain the stamina and edge he'd lost during recuperation. He made a few more appearances through the season but was well short of previous season's form. Subsequently loaned to Forest 18/3/97 for 1 month; Sold to Aberdeen 1/7/97 who sold him for 350k. to Wolfsburg in Germany who swapped him to Derby; Most of his time at Derby he was out injured. He was recently released and after training with Kilmarnock has found a short term deal at Preston.  |

He had further surgery before being moved to Glasgow. It was thought that if he walked again he wouldn't play. Further surgery put three metal plates into his pelvis and led to his retirement from football. He appeared at the ground on crutches on 28/10 for the Aberdeen game and married the mother of his child. He made a slow recovery and was awarded a Testimonial on 3/3/96. Sturm Graz, AEK Athens and a number of other unnamed Greek sides came in for him but he chose to stay, though by January he reconsidered. He trialed at Southend but turned the £120k move down. After discussions with Burns it was agreed that he would stay. Part of this might have been to do Rangers. He subsequently retired at the end of 95/96 to concentrate on media opportunities and is now a frontman for SKY.   |
