West Mersea seconds scored their first victory in Division Two on Saturday, when condemning Clacton Ramblers to their third successive defeat. Batting first Mersea made a steady start with James Tilsley and Neil Goodridge putting on 44 for the first wicket. Goodridge (47) continued the steady momentum with Mick Laver (27) and the team were well placed at 110 for 1 in the 28<sup>th</sup> over. Luke Conway then arrived at the crease and blasted a typically aggressive 58 from just 31 balls which included four maximums. Mel Hughes guided the tail cleverly with an unbeaten 25 to see Mersea up to a respectable 226. A Daniels and C Bruce both claimed three wickets a piece for Ramblers.

Clacton made a good start with N Smith (28) and A Daniels (52) putting on 67 in thirteen overs. However, the complexion of the game changed with introduction in tandem of Reg Sheldrick (2 for 26) and Mike Srinivasan (3 for 35), who made the inroads into the top order including danger men Steve James and Clayton Jeffrey, and bowled economically to put the home side well behind the required rate. Trevor Vince was then took three cheap wickets in his second spell as the Ramblers succumbed to 174 all out.
