Eight Ash Green gave West Mersea second's a very stern test for their opening Division Two match, and batting first the islanders soon found life difficult. Mersea were going along steadily enough reaching 37 in the ninth over, Digs Taylor composing what was eventually the highest Mersea score of 18, for the loss of a single wicket. However, from 37 for 1 they then slumped catastrophically to 49 for 6. N Ukwatte (2 for 17) and an excellent unchanged spell from R Olejnik (3 for 20) doing the damage. Srinivasan and Fuller reached double figures to see Mersea up to 86 all out in the 29th over. Hill 2 for 19 and Woodcock 2 for 5 mopped up the tail.

In reply Eight Ash Green took little time to reach the target, getting home in the 20th over for the loss of Richard Polley for 22. Last weeks centurion Keith Hammond was 29 not out, and Woodcock 24 not out.
