Mersea did battle well with Sheldrick and Vince getting in amongst the wickets, and skipper Nod Goodridge claimed his first 'five for' for the club as the Green went for quick runs off his enticing lobs. Mel Hughes took three stumpings off Goodridge as the Green eventually reached a tea time total of 231 for 9.

Mersea were quickly on the back foot when their turn came to bat, A Woodcock in particular causing problems for the islanders as he claimed five of the first six batsmen on his way to figures of 6 for 20. Trevor Vince put up some resolute defence with 42, but Mersea were way short of the target when they were bowled out for 114 in the 41<sup>st</sup> over.
