A meeting with Harwich & Dovercourt on the 22nd September saw the Mersea history books rewritten. Harwich batted first and plundered runs from the Mersea bowling. D Goff leading the way with 161, and enjoying a 186 run stand for the third wicket with J King (77). Trevor Vince was the most successful Mersea bowler with 2 for 47 as the home side posted an impregnable 329 for 5.

Mersea were in trouble pretty quickly slumping to 19 for 3, with the unfortunate Tom Bower being run out without facing a ball in the first over. James Rutter was joined by captain Luke Conway who in scoring is 17th run reached the 1000 run milestone. The pair put on 113 for the 4th wicket with Conway eventually going for 83. Rutter went through to a maiden senior fifty, eventually finishing with 60 as Mersea finally were bowled out in the final over for 202.
