The seconds remained undefeated with a fourth successive victory to take them to the top of the third division. Kirby who were previously unbeaten themselves could only muster eight men, and with the exception of George Wilson (40) and Bernard (21*) were totally out played. Tom Sanderson (2 for 29) claimed the prize scalp of Wilson, whilst there were economical spells from Vince 0 for 14 from 7, and Colin Lamb 1 for 13 from 7. Nod Goodridge capitalised at the end of the innings to mop up the tail with 3 for 7 as Kirby were bowled out for 92.

In reply Mersea lost skipper Goodridge cheaply for 4, but then Digs Taylor and Mick Laver (22) put on a fifty stand to take control of the game. Digs eventually ended 57 not out, with ten fours, as Mersea reached their target for the loss of only two wickets in 25 overs.
