South Cambridgeshire District Council is carrying out a review of parishing arrangements to accommodate the new settlement of Cambourne and has published draft recommendations for the establishment of a new parish of Cambourne and appropriate consequential electoral arrangements for that parish and the adjustment of the relevant boundaries of the adjoining parishes of Knapwell, Caxton and Bourn as well as District Council ward representation.
