E001	<p><u>Improved Registration and error handling.</u></p> <p>1) Provision of two distinct routs through Help/Registration/apply for Pcs with/without an Internet connection, each route with better advice at each stage of the process. Use 'SendMail' to transmit Registration Request where appropriate.</p> <p>2) A 'SendMail' mechanism to send emails direct to MRTT support via your Internet connection. Anonymous transmission option.</p> <p>3) Error Handling extended to trap ALL errors - at the moment it traps most! Option to send an error report via 'SendMail', either anonymously or with your email address if you are happy to be contacted.</p> <p>4) New facility Help/Contact to send your Praise or Otherwise via 'SendMail'.</p> <p>5) Also - for Stephe Jitts (Australia) - increase allowed number of Stations to 15.</p>	1.0.2.0	22/09/06
E002	<p><u>Extended Run Options</u></p> <p>1) Option to switch off Cancellation messages (Timetabled Mode) - don't tell the Public when you mess it up! Also increase size of Cancel Advice when produced.</p> <p>2) Option to turn off LATE reporting in Timetable Mode.</p> <p>3) Allow Train data display in the first column, currently only used for 'LATE' reporting in Timetable Mode. 'Flash' screen to show LATE if appropriate.</p> <p>4) Option to allow an extra train data column at right by reducing the From/To location sizes (user selects field size).</p> <p>5) Allow mouse use in Run as well as the keyboard. i.e. Right click for menu of all available & appropriate options (help, close, next, stop/start etcetera).</p> <p>6) Add 'not' selection criteria to Filter (i.e. NOT from Newcastle).</p> <p>7) Minor improvements/revisions to 'Find' Option in Edit Item.</p> <p>8) When a train becomes late, unless the option is turned off, display and advice using a random excuse as per Cancellations. E004	For manual skip only, a skip now moves direct to the appropriate arr/dep/pass time for a train item – i.e. ignoring the train display start time. Better for sequence operation! Also my ISP NTL was blocking direct access from many other ISPs to my email account as an anti-spam measure. I have therefore withdrawn the ‘direct’ email options in Help/Contact and Help/Registration.
