FIXED WING TRAINING LOG

The following checklist of flying manoeuvres is intended to help members to prepare for their 'A' Certificate. It should be brought to the field each time you receive instruction. Your Instructor will "sign off" each manoeuvre when you can repeat it to the required standard.

All manoeuvres must be carried out in front of the pilot; circuits must be at a constant height and the figure of eight crossover point adequately centred. Due allowance will be made for wind strength and direction.

For training purposes the schedule has been broken down into separate components. The 'A' test is not outrageously difficult; it requires you to demonstrate that you are in control of your aeroplane at all times.

Remember the emphasis is always on SAFE, QUIET flying.

Refer to the current 'A' test requirements described in the BMFA Manual.
