### INTRODUCTION

The Artificial Slope Snowboard Instructor (ASSBI) programme is designed to train and qualify responsible snowboarders to instruct on artificial surfaces. The ASSBI training course will contain five days of practical snowboarding activity supplemented with a supporting programme of lectures, seminars and tutor-led discussion. The ASSBI training programme and qualification does not permit the holder to instruct or lead snowboarders on snow (except indoor snow facilities).

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Before attending an ASSBI course the candidate must:

be able to perform smooth linked turns on an artificial surface

be at least 18 years of age. In exceptional circumstances a candidate aged 17 years may attend the course if he/she passes the course then certification will be withheld until he/she is 18 years old

### COURSE OVERVIEW

In general terms the ASSBI course focuses on the following areas:

- \* Snowboard technique
- \* Lesson planning
- \* Class management and safety
- \* Use of uplift
- \* Snowboard equipment
- \* Snowboard learning progression
- \* Lesson delivery
- \* Dealing with accidents and emergencies
- \* Use of small jumps
- \* Child protection and other ethical issues

### ASSESSMENT & APPEALS

Candidates technical and teaching skills are assessed over the duration of the course through continual appraisal of practical sessions. Candidates will be expected to demonstrate an understanding of the material covered during the course and be able to assimilate this into a practical context. Candidates will also be assessed on their knowledge and understanding by means of a written paper and discussion sessions. If the assessor decides that the candidate is not yet competent in any area, an action plan agreed after the assessment, will give clear guidance as to what the candidate must do before the next assessment opportunity. Candidates have the right to appeal against any decision and those appeals should be made in writing to the Programme Director at Snowsport Wales.

### QUALIFICATION

On successful completion of the ASSBI training course, candidates must fulfil the following criteria before they are awarded the Artificial Slope Snowboard Instructor award:

- \* Hold a First Aid Certificate (Emergency First Aid Minimum)
- \* Be at least 18 years of age
- \* Be a member of the Snowsport Wales Coaching Scheme
