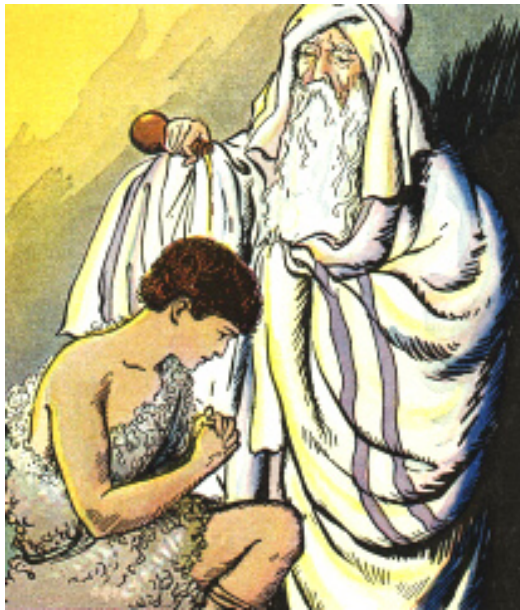


Young David is chosen to be King



Your Bible reading

Jesse sent someone to get his youngest son.....The Lord said to Samuel, "Get up and anoint him. He is the one."
(1 Samuel Chapter 16 verse 12)

The story of David begins.....

David was the youngest in his family. He was the least important. But as soon as Samuel saw David, God said, "This is the one." God chose David to be the next King of Israel. Samuel put oil on David's head as a sign from God. This is called anointing.

Why did God chose David?

The Bible tells us why in Acts Chapter 3 verse 22:

This is what God said about David:
"David, son of Jesse, is a man who is like me in his thinking. He will do all the things I want him to do."

God looked at what David was like inside. God knew that David wanted the same things that He wanted. David pleased God. That is why God chose David to do a very special job.

Think about it

It doesn't matter to God what we look like. It doesn't matter to God how important we are. God looks at what we are like inside. He is looking for people who want to follow Him and serve Him today.


