Theme: The Great Commission

Questions and Discussion Points

1. What were the main points and principles of Sunday's teaching?
2. Are you fulfilling the *Great Commission (GC)*?
3. Should the *GC* be the central principle of the life of every disciple of Jesus and, in fact, the central principle of every church?
4.
 - a. Should Paul's task also be ours? (Acts 20:24)
 - b. Should we have the same attitude as Paul? (Philippians 3:12-14)
 - c. What was the attitude of Jesus? (Luke 4:43; John 9:4)
5. How should we live as disciples of Jesus? (Luke 9:62; Ephesians 5:15-16)
6. Have you begun to witness to your friends, neighbours and relatives; to those people you know at work or school; to others you know in your social activities? If you haven't, should you start?
7. Why hasn't Jesus returned before now? (2 Peter 3:9, 15)
8. Does your life point people to Jesus, or away from Him?
9. Have you allowed room or given opportunity in your life to be a witness for Jesus and so begun to fulfil the *GC*?

Summary & Application

1. Every disciple of Jesus has been commissioned to go and make disciples for Jesus?
2. God loves mankind so much He sent His only Son Jesus to die for us. If mankind does not accept God's provision, he will be eternally lost. We, as disciples of Jesus, need to reach out to others in the power of the Holy Spirit to prevent this from happening.
3. Jesus will return and the end will come when the gospel of the Kingdom of God is preached to all nations (Matthew 24:14).
4. Our lives should be a witness, in themselves, to Jesus.
5. The prime reason for the coming of the Holy Spirit is to equip disciples of Jesus for witness.
6. If we don't reach our generation, no one else will!
7. The experienced truth of God is what will change our lives and what will seem real to others as they look at our lives.
8. As disciples of Jesus who know the love and power of God, we should want all people on earth to enjoy the same.
