Dear Mr Murphy and Mr Wells,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 27.6.06 to which I will send a detailed reply shortly.

I fully understand the concerns of the Stockton Heath Primary School Action Group. We has a similar situation here in Lymm some 15 or so years ago when it was proposed to demolish the former Lymm Grammar School to relocate two secondary schools on one site. Lymm Grammar School was founded in 1660 and moved to the Grammar School Rd site in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. It was a lovely old building. I was a pupil at the school as was my husband and we met through the LGS Old Students Association. Our four children also attended the school so we had a very strong attachment to that building. There was a great deal of local concern and upset when the demolition was proposed and strong opposition from old students many living across the world. It was made worse because the school playing fields were sold for development to fund the new buildings in Oughtrington Lane. We lost part of Lymm's history and it was a very difficult time. I hope you see why I feel I understand the concerns of your Action Group.
