Stockton Heath Community Primary School

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 28(1) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 that Warrington Borough Council intend to make a prescribed alteration to Stockton Heath Primary School, Egerton Street, Stockton Heath, Warrington, Cheshire, WA4 6DT by an enlargement of the premises of the school from 1 September 2008.

The number of pupils at the school is 336. The capacity of the school is 333.

The proposed capacity of the school is to be 420. The planned admission number for the school is to remain at 60 per year group, which would total 420 pupils. Please note that the number of pupils eligible to attend the school will not be increasing. This notice is to gain permission to increase the size of the school premises (i.e. buildings) only, from the current net capacity of 333 to increase to 420.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the school at age 4 from 1 September 2008 and subsequent years will remain at 60.

Please note that this notice supersedes the notice published on the 19 October 2006 but any comments already received will be sent to the School Organisation Committee.

Within six weeks after the date of publication of these proposals, any person may object to or make comments on the proposals by sending the representations to:
