ENABLING WORKS TO STOCKTON HEATH COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL DURING THE EASTER HOLIDAYS

As you are aware the Development Control Committee approved the planning application for the rebuilding of Stockton Heath Community Primary School. The main contractors are expected to start on the school site at the end of the Summer Term in July 2007. Before the main works begin there will be some enabling works that will need to be completed during the Easter holidays (but not including the bank holiday weekend). The enabling works will consist of:

- A new entrance on Egerton Street;
- Extending the entrance on Brackley Street;
- Delivery of a mobile kitchen;
- Various adaptations inside the school to accommodate the new kitchen facility and Stay and Play link club.

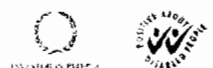
The new school building will be positioned where the buildings are for the kitchen/dining, Year 6 HORSAs and all-weather pitch. These facilities will be removed at various stages. When the site is cleared it will be thoroughly checked for archaeological findings.

To replace the kitchen HORSAs a new mobile kitchen will be installed to ensure that hot school dinners can be provided to the children during the course of the building works. The mobile kitchen will be delivered on Monday 2nd April 2007. Due to the restrictions to the access of the school site and the logistics of the delivery it has been necessary to request a closure to Brackley Street for this day. It would be

appreciated if you could leave the entrance to the school on Brackley Street clear on both sides of the road. If this part of the road can be kept clear it will assist in the delivery of the kitchen and allow the road closure to be removed as soon as possible. It is hoped that the closure will be for a minimum amount of time and that it will not inconvenience you too much. A similar process will also be required for the delivery of a mobile classroom to the site in August 2007. A further notice and letter will be published nearer the time.
