Ground Annuals payable in virtue of Con. of Ground Annual (recorded County of Renfrew 7th Sept. 1844) between Thomas Colledge and John Grey White Glasgow as Trustees therein mentioned and Francis Steel Colledge viz (1) Ground Annual of £3. 2. 2 furth of 1 Rood 9^{7/8} poles of ground on plan and (2) a Ground Annual of £3. 8. 11 furth of 1 Rood 15^{7/8} poles on said plan both bounded on west north west by Road from Stewarton by Pollokshaws to Glasgow now known as Thornliebank Road and on east by north by Hillside Road in Parish of Eastwood.

DEED OF WAIVER by MERCHANTS' HOUSE OF GLASGOW, LORD DEAN OF GUILD OF GLASGOW and Collector of Merchants' House of Glasgow, holders of Ground Annuals over (I) 1 Rood 9^{7/8} poles of ground, and (II) 1 Rood 15^{7/8} poles of ground, both bounded on west north west by Road from Stewarton by Pollokshaws to Glasgow, now known as THORNIEBANK ROAD [and on east by north by HILLSIDE ROAD], in Parish of Eastwood, described in Con. of Ground Annual to which Francis Steel Colledge was a party, recorded County of Renfrew 7th Sept. 1877 - WAIVING the obligation to erect a House on each of said plots of ground as therein mentioned and the prohibition of sub-division of House erected on said plots of ground contained in said Con. of Ground Annual to effect of permitting said House to be divided into two slated Houses. Dated Dec. 13, 1961 and Feb. 20, 1962; with two Warrants thereon, one on behalf of John Thomson Logie, formerly 17 Maxwell Drive, now Littlewood, 41 Thornliebank Road, Glasgow and the other on behalf of said Merchants' House of Glasgow and said Lord Dean of Guild and Collector for behoof of Merchants' House of Glasgow.
