

## Fugitive Fantasy League Rules 2008

1. The Fugitive Fantasy League (FFL) is open to all club members of Newport Fugitives and anyone else who can be bothered (friends, family etc as long as they pay up I don't care).
2. Games to be included in the FFL are any completed senior 1<sup>st</sup> XI, 2<sup>nd</sup> XI league fixture and Saturday / Sunday friendly fixture from 12<sup>th</sup> April 2008. Tour Games also count this year so get yourselves on tour as we will play up to six matches!! Newport & District midweek league matches won't count – nor will the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary games.
3. The cost is £5 per team or as a special deal individuals can submit 3 teams for £10.
4. You must choose 11 different players from the list below and their combined value must not exceed £12 million. **IF YOUR NAME IS ON THE LIST YOU MUST CHOOSE YOURSELF.** The value apportioned to players is purely at the discretion of RT and 2007 points total is only meant to be used as a guide as other factors can influence values. I haven't split players into batsman, bowler, keeper etc so pick who you like!
5. There will be no substitutions because once the competition is underway I can't be bothered to do any more admin (totalling the scores is more than enough work).
6. There will be no starman for the week coz that's just plain stupid.
7. Teams must be submitted to Russell (RT) by hand or via e-mail but teams will not become active until you receive a receipt from RT. RT is not responsible for any lost / erroneously completed applications. It is recommended that your team(s) are submitted before the first game of the season (12<sup>th</sup> April) as teams submitted after that date will only accumulate points for the games played subsequent to receipt. RT's decision on all matters is final and I'll be using the official scorebooks.
8. The winner will receive 30% of the final takings and a trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize 20%, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize 10% with the other 40% going to the manager of the month and the club (after costs of course – I'm not made of money). In the event of a tie, the winnings are shared equally among the winning individuals.
9. A £10 prize will be awarded for the most points accumulated in a full month (i.e. May, June, July & August – not April or September). In the event of a tie, the player who climbed more places during that month will be adjudged the winner.
10. There will be no prizes for the most inventive team name (Go out and buy The Sun if you want to enter something like that!!)
11. There will be regular updates (but only via e-mail, the website and one poster at the club) so please submit your e-mail address on the form if you want to receive these updates.
12. RT reserves the right to refuse to accept any application which in his opinion does not comply with these terms and conditions or which contravenes the spirit of the FFL competition. RT further has an absolute discretion to disqualify any entry, or vary, amend or waive the rules of the competition at any time and participants agree that no liability shall attach itself to RT as a result thereof and that the exercise of such discretion shall not result in any compensation being payable or paid to any participant, manager or Chairman. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these terms and conditions... blah, blah, blah – Now get on with it!!!
