

Traffic

Congestion :

- Stoughton Bridge needs two lanes
- Manor Road traffic speeding
- No bus route through QE Park
- Traffic congestion Manor Road and top of Grange Road
- No to one way traffic in Manor Road as this will encourage speeding
- Percy Road development used to be a through road but is now a cul de sac so less danger
- Bus route – Grange Road/Railton Road
- Buses to turn up on schedule
- Illuminated warnings in both Manor Road and Grange Road
- 30 mph signs needed
- 20 mph signs needed
- QEP developers promised traffic calming measures
- If the bridge was closed then traffic using Stoughton as a rat run would vanish
- Too much traffic due to QEP
- One way traffic from Spar
- HGV signs 7.5 ton max needs to be enforced in Stoughton Road
- Safe routes for schools, town, railways, etc
- Taxis use Manor Road as a rat run
- Stoughton Road bridge has a weight limit, police should enforce
- HGVs use Grange Road as rat run
- Keep the bus service on Grange Road – if it works why change it?
- Research the bus demand. Buses are virtually empty
- How useful are CCTV cameras?

Traffic

Roads :

- Volume of traffic – 3,264 vehicles per day – is this because of QEP? Is another traffic survey due?
- Speed of traffic is too high
- Speeding – mobile speed trap, flashing speed limit signs, improved traffic calming
- 20 mph speed limit for all of Stoughton
- Congestion charging for Guildford
- Speed humps and signage
- One way system for local roads
- If local roads are closed what about emergency services & buses?
- Pollution is a problem
- Reduce standing traffic
- Make trouble spots one way
- Avoid further domestic building, which produces increased traffic
- All of the roads in Grange and Willow Park need to be resurfaced
- More speed restriction signs needed
- Accidents are waiting to happen
- Advance warnings need to be given for street cleaning but not on Sundays – too many vehicles on the streets
- Changing lights cause excessive speeding
- Illuminated 'Slow Down' signs
- Speed restriction signs

Environment :

- Lower rents for shops to enable business people to afford them.
- Businesses might be encouraged into the area if money was spent on landscaping of foot bridge and Woodbridge Hill area
- Improved street lighting
- Better lighting required
- Improved welcome signs entering Stoughton
- All of the roads in Grange and Willow Park need to be resurfaced
- Old road work signs in place after a year work has finished
- Entrance to Stoughton off Salt Box Road is a rubbish tip
- Footpath over Stoughton bridge is too narrow for some buggies
- Too much litter
- Dog bins need to be emptied more frequently
- Broken glass needs to be cleared
- Buses should run on gas
- Bus route as planned into QE park is next to the only green area where children are playing
- Hedges need cutting back
- Footpaths, roads and drains need to be cleaned
- Council charges need to be reviewed
- More dry litter bins required
- Noise in the area, car radios, etc..
- Dust pollution from QEP?
- Safety issue at Emmanuel Church crossroads – pelican crossing required Stoughton Road/Shepherds Lane
- Infrastructure and services cannot support further development
- Why cut down trees in QE Park?
- More tree planting and landscaping required eg. Wooden Bridge area
- Arson?
- Antisocial behaviour in QE Park late at night
- Why spoil a natural multifunctional kickabout area for a hard court in QE Park?

Community

Sense of Community :

- Communication ? newsletters?

- Safe play areas for children
- Disenfranchise the altered ward boundaries
- No facilities for youth or the elderly – free transport and clubs are required
- We have no sense of community
- Preserve the Village Green on QE Park
- Basket ball court was included in Stoughton Rec budget
- Basketball court could go in the school on Grange Road or at the Rec
- Young people from Christ College should have a say
- Increased use of ASBs to control antisocial behaviour
- Litter, vandalism, noise late at night
- Stoughton is suffering from the overspill from Park Barn curfew
- More activities are required for the youth
- Neighbourhood watch and a visible police presence is needed
- Care by landlords and better vetting of tenants. Some form of penalty for landlords if incidents are repeated

Community Centre :

- We need a community centre
- Small or not at all
- New community Centre on QEP – Location, Activities?
- Private QEP company enforcing fees for community centre on QEP residents?
- Why is QEP paying for the community centre for all of Stoughton residents?
- We need a community centre – if it cannot be built in QEP what about Stoughton Grange School?
- When will the community centre be built?
- A social centre is needed for all ages
- A need for research for the demand/ management/ business plan
- Utilise existing buildings before building new
- No drinks licence
- QEP's attitude – village environment was sold to new residents versus the rest of Stoughton sold the idea the community centre would serve all of Stoughton
- The nursery site at Shepherds Hill planned to be a council development – could this be an alternative site for the community centre?
