**GRANGE ROAD, STOUGHTON  
THE PROBLEM**

Surrey County Council is concerned for pedestrian safety in the southern section of Grange Road, Stoughton. Grange Road is very narrow between Northmead School and Stoughton Road, and the pavements are very narrow on both sides. Parking in this section narrows the road further so that there is not enough width for two-way traffic. Southbound drivers routinely drive on the pavement to avoid conflict with northbound drivers, creating a safety hazard for pedestrians. There are reports of children en route to Northmead School being struck by vehicles.

**OPTIONS AND CONSEQUENCES**

There are three feasible options for Grange Road:

1. Implement waiting restrictions (single and double yellow lines) in the southern section of Grange Road, to prevent parking at the times when the problem occurs
2. Implement a one-way system in the southern section of Grange Road
3. Do nothing

These options have numerous consequences including pedestrian safety, parking provision, the 26/27 bus route, displaced traffic and displaced parking.
