Dalby Forest, Pickering, North Yorkshire



The Saturday and Sunday events will be to **Regional** standard with limited Colour Coded courses. Monday will be for the **Relays**. There will also be a **Bike O** on the Sunday.

Location: The event centre, parking and campsite will be at High Rigg Farm (GR SE 865888), 8 miles from Pickering.

Terrain: The majority of this area has not been used for orienteering since the mid 1970's and varies from naturally re-seeded fast, runnable & mature deciduous forest to younger replanted coniferous woodland. The area is characterised by long NE / SW spurs and valleys which contain some intricate fine detail and will offer great route choice legs and a number of interesting technical problems

Pre-Entries (not Colour Coded) are accepted in the following ways:

- On-line entry system available through www.eborienteers.org.uk Please note that this cannot be used for Relay entries and is for the Individual days, E-Card hire, Car Parking & Camping permits.
- Enclosed entry form (photocopies accepted), which includes Relay entries.

Final details can be held at the event centre for you, please request this facility at the time of entry.

Entries on the Day (EOD): Badge event maps will be pre-marked and entries will be subject to map/course availability. Colour Coded courses are EOD only.

Saturday and Sunday's Badge Events are separate events. **White Rose Trophies** for individuals will be based on the competitor's cumulative time for both days. Pre-entry or EOD prior to Saturday registration closing time will qualify. The entry form allows for a choice of start time on the Saturday, but Sunday is calculated to provide a balanced start time.

Badge classes: This year we have agreed to participate in a BOF sponsored trial of a new system aimed at simplifying regional events. The intention is to encourage competitors to enter a course that suits them in terms of length and technical difficulty, rather than based on their age.

The provisional proposals are as follows:
