**Courses/
Classes:**

As a warm up for the new relay format for this years White Rose. All except the E class take the form of a Team Score Event in which all three members of the team will start at the same time and will decide who will visit which controls, with the intention of picking up the maximum number of points between them within a period of 1 hour.

Class E for the very youngest juniors will remain in standard relay format rather than a team score competition.

Class B	TD5 x 3	120+, All W, at least 1W, Ad hoc
Class C & D	TD5, TD5, TD3	120+ all W, 160+, Family (2 parents) 48-, 48- all W, Family (1 parent)
Class E	TD2/3	M/W-12

The Team Score event is Open – i.e. team members do not have to be from the same club

Note: Td2 = yellow Td3 = orange Td4 = light green Td5 = green/blue

Information: After starting there will be 4 or 5 compulsory controls that each team member must visit. The rest of the controls can be split between the team. There will be a compulsory last control and a holding area. The team must finish together.
