#### Class 11 Minor Puppy Bitch

1. 104 **Cubanba Northern Star** Well developing puppy, very good neck, head, very good, appropriate to age chest, correct angulation, puppy movement, well presented
- 2.100 **Krishan Blue Bell** Good frame, a little bit subtle height, well set neck, head a bit too fine, correct angulation, movement still loose.

#### Class 12 Puppy Bitch

1. 114 **Jahadi Nadine** very well balanced puppy in every proportion, excellent head, well set ear, neck of an appropriate length, very good top line, correct angulation, already very good movement, well set tail, excellent presentation
2. 90 **Keamarola Karlesha** a bit longer frame, very good head, neck, a bit steep shoulder, correct chest, gait a bit short.

#### Class 13 Veteran Bitch

1. 98 **Ch Nanak Freecloud Firenze** elegant veteran, excellent condition, well muscled to age, movement still elegant, quality coat, excellently presented.
2. 103 **Araki Hairy Mary** very good frame with excellent head, very good topline, excellent condition, well muscled, very good movement.

#### Class 14 Junior Bitch

1. 25 **Mhasud Lady Starlight** A bit smaller to her age but very well proportionally balanced, excellent topline and underline, well set tail, correct angulation, very good movement.
2. 62 **Altside Blu For You** very good frame, enough substance, excellent head with perfect eye, neck long enough, good front, very good angulation, not well presented in movement.

#### Class 15 Yearling Bitch

1. 139 **Xenos Inca Bruna At Altside (Imp)** Elegant bitch with excellent “glow”, bit more narrow front, very good head with almond eye, good neck, excellent topline, excellent angulation rear and front, excellent movement with proud head carriage.
2. 25 **Mhasud Lady Starlight** in this class I missed better “glowing” in presentation.

#### Class 16 Novice Bitch

1. 101 **Krishan Forget-Me-Not** Bitch with a very good head, well set ear, correct eye, good back, I would appreciate more substance, narrower front, very good movement.
2. 145 **Azari Opal Mist** bitch with a good head, excellent eye, neck a bit shorter, very good topline, chest nicely deep, correct angulation, spacious movement.

#### Class 17 Graduate Bitch

1. 136 **Altside Bimbo Bagins** elegant bitch of excellent frame and enough substance, elegant head, excellent neck, excellent topline, excellent chest, very good angulation, excellent movement, quality maintained coat.
2. 2 **Sarakhan Swansong JW** bitch with a very good head, excellent eye and ear, well set neck, a bit narrower front, enough depth of chest, excellent angulation rear and front, very good movement, well presented

#### Class 18 Post Graduate Bitch

1. 24 **Kazzlyn She's The One At Mhasud JW ShCM** elegant bitch with excellent head, well set and carried ear, excellent neck, a little longer topline, correct angulation, excellent front, it is clearly visible this bitch likes to stay in kitchen, I would appreciate slenderer forms, correct movement.
2. 65 **Gezancol Dolly Day Dream JW** correct bitch, a bit narrower in front, with very good head, eye and ear, well set neck, excellent topline, enough depth of chest, very good shoulder, excellent movement, well presented

#### Class 19 Limit Bitch

1. 99 **Alouann Hot N Spicy At Orashan JW ShCM** elegant bitch with excellent frame, head, neck, top- and underline, excellent front, excellent chest, excellent angulation, elegant gait with “beaming”, excellently presented, excellent coat
2. 130 **Birkhall Sophia** excellent bitch in every way, excellent presentation, energetic movement.

#### Class 20 Open Bitch

1. 40 **UK/INT/PORT/SP Ch Saxonmill Star Style** elegant bitch with proud head carriage, excellent almond eye, well set ear, excellent neck, excellent topline and front, excellent deep chest, correct angulation, excellent rich coat, I would appreciate more “glow” in movement, excellently presented
2. 138 **CH Altside Yanjoy Winny The Blu** excellent bitch with excellent head, good neck, excellent firm back, deep enough chest, a bit steeper angulation in front, correct in rear, perfectly presented.

#### Class 1 Minor Puppy Dog

1. 87 **Istani Major Tom** well developing puppy with well developing body structure, well forming angulation, gait still joyful.
2. 86 **Istani Father McKenzie** well developing puppy, good head, well set neck, a bit steeper shoulder at the moment, well developing chest, movement still loose.

#### Class 2 Puppy Dog

1. 28 **Nagazumi Moscato** well developing puppy, a bit narrower front, well set neck, well forming angulation, and muscles, cute character, gait still bit “topsy turvy”.
2. 131 **Nagazumi Verdelho** well developing puppy with a good head, a bit narrower front, well developing chest, good angulation, cute character, movement appropriate to age.

#### Class 3 Veteran Dog

1. 69 **Calmon Red October** excellent condition, still excellently muscular, excellent gait with a proud head carriage, excellent coat, well presented.

#### Class 4 Junior Dog

1. 39 **Agha Djaris World Is Not Enough (Imp)** elegant dog with an excellent head, almond eye, well set ear, correct neck, steeper shoulder, good front, correct back, well set and carried tail, very good gait, friendly character
2. 13 **Afterglow Jumping Rainbows of Sofica** dog with a bit longer topline, very good head, good eye, correct neck, good front, a bit smaller size, with excellent angulation, excellent movement.

#### Class 5 Yearling Dog

1. 26 **Mhasud Unforgettable** well built dog with a very good head, excellent neck, very good chest, firm back, very good movement, the best in the class.
- 2.137 **Altside Red Hot N'Blu** very good frame, excellent head with good expression, excellent top- and underline, a bit steeper front, correct angulation in rear, good muscled, correct movement, very well presented.

#### Class 6 Novice Dog

1. 144 **Azmari Black Diamond** very good dog with very good proportions, very good head, correct eye and ear, well set neck, very good angulation, excellent gait with “glow”.
- 2.88 **Drishaun Darkness** well built dog with a very good head, almond eye, a bit shorter neck, excellent topline, deep chest, a bit steeper shoulder, movement front and rear a bit tight.

#### Class 7 Graduate Dog

1. 123 **Gezancol Done and Dhusted at Nabilah JW** excellent two year old dog with an elegant head, well set eye, good neck, excellent topline, very good deep chest, correct angulation, excellent movement.
2. 39 **Agha Djaris World Is Not Enough (Imp)** the winner of the class was better in movement and was better presented. In this class it is a second place.

#### Class 8 Post Graduate Dog

1. 51 **Sashkan Final Dividend** well built dog with an excellent head, long enough neck, excellent strong bones, a bit steeper shoulder, excellent back, round ribs, correct rear angulation, nice character, very good movement..
2. 156 **Aramaic Shout To The Top** very good dog, head with a good expression, well set ears, a bit shorter neck, very well angulated rear and front, good front, excellent heel, very good movement, I would appreciate more glowing in moving.

#### Class 9 Limit Dog

1. 157 **Saxonmill Sirius** elegant dog in every way, proud head carriage, almond eye, excellent neck, excellent top- and underline, excellent forechest, excellent bones, elegant gait, excellently presented.
2. 97 **Tolah In Demons Image** very good dog with a very good head, very good neck, firm back, very good hips, correct angulation, good front, correct movement, a little shy.

#### Class 10 Open Dog

1. 37 **Shadowfax Ciao Sabbioso JW ShCM** Five year old dog, excellent head, almond eye, elegant neck, a bit sloping back, excellent chest, correct front, correct angulation rear and front, strong bones, excellent gait, well presented.
2. 68 **Bellapis Kimani Hrhashid** Six year old dog with a good head, elegant eye, good neck, excellent topline, steeper angulation in front, a little cow-hocked, rear movement tight a little, short gait

It was an honour and my pleasure to accept your invitation and to judge at your open show in Worcester. It was my first judging in Great Britain and I was looking forward to your show. I have judged almost in every European country but the number of Afghans at Worcester show overcame my expectations. The number of Afghans entered was simply amazing. Class winners were, in my opinion, all very elegant. Regarding the Afghans presented at the show in general, I noticed some faults in more than half of them, e.g. narrow front, steeper shoulder, gait not spacious enough, weaker lower jaw, shy characters.

These faults can, of course, be found also in continental Afghans and I think it has been a problem for several last years.

I would like to thank to the Birmingham Afghan Hound Club for allowing me to judge your show and for their care they provided during my stay in England.

And finally I would like to wish a Happy New Year and a lot of success in breeding and showing to all your members.
