FASH Chat

As I write this, we have just had a super day at the FASH workshop on Running Set with Mike Courthold. Everyone enjoyed it, everyone messed it up from time to time, everyone needed lots of help from Mike and others in the set. And the music from Andrew Purkiss was perfect. Though how he managed to keep going for the last dance, that ran for 15-20 minutes, I don't know.

There was one snag. There were not enough of us there. We had 12-16 people during the day. Now this was great in that it meant that we could have a lot of fun with the dances, learn quickly because of personal attention and thus do lots of new things. But financially we can't keep running these sessions unless we can cover our costs.

At the last AGM, we had a discussion about all this and we reached the conclusion that we didn't want to do without live music, we didn't want to put up the FASH membership costs (by the way this is very cheap at £6, so anyone reading this who is not a FASH member, but would like to support Folk – why not give us a call, using the contacts on the back page) and we didn't want to put up the workshop prices. Instead we wanted to all try and get to the workshops as much as possible and encourage others to do the same.

Since then, I have been "promoted" to be the treasurer and so care even more about the cash. It is quite simple, either we get more people to these workshops, or we will have to stop running them at some time in the foreseeable future, or we have to price things differently. There is no immediate crisis, but having watched several lots of politicians and bankers (here and in Greece) over the last few years kind of put off bad news, hoping

that something might solve things, we ought to try and not do the same thing.

So, please come and support the next workshop. It is on November 6th and will cover the dances of Pat Shaw. As avid Solent Waves readers will no doubt have read in the September edition Pat wrote lots of nice dances in the period up to 1977. These will be super dances to dance, and anyone will be able to pick them up.

Actually one of the things I find really nice about these Sunday workshops is how people are there ready to help others. We have made a point of it within the committee, to say hallo to people, chat, be a partner for anyone single and so on. If I turn my back I find Daphne Hall has leapt in and is dancing with a new partner, or is saying hallo to someone she hasn't yet met!

Next season we think we might experiment with Saturday workshops or having them at Twyford. Indeed we would be willing to try anything to be able to keep doing these workshops. They have been running for so many years it would be such a shame if they had to stop. All ideas welcome.

I hope to see you At Soberton Village Hall 10.30 Sunday November 6th, having had a nice cup of coffee, ready to dance to the great live music from the accordion of David Roberts. Yesterday, some people went to the pub for lunch, some people had their own dietary needs and so had brought lunch, and others shared in the bring and share style – we welcome whatever your preference.

And don't forget the dance on Saturday evening at Twyford on November 26th. Please call 01489 892911 and reserve a place in case we sell out.

Baroque

If you fancy doing a completely different activity this autumn, how about trying Baroque dance and learning some wonderfully elegant dances such as the minuet, gavotte, saraband and bouree?

How would you also like to attend some magnificent 18th century balls at several chateaux in France and at various grand events in Italy and Germany in 2012?

A local group of dancers who have a shared interest in historical dance have decided to set up regular 17th and 18th century dance classes in Winchester. One of this country's leading dance experts, Barbara Segal, will be running the classes which are just getting going. They will take place on various Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings in central Winchester. It is aimed at total beginners, so everyone will be most welcome.

The group would also be interested in hearing from anyone interested in playing 18th century music for the dancers. In addition to the classes, participants will also be given advice on how to make an 18th century costume, although this is not obligatory.

Baroque dance was the precursor to ballet and was mostly danced between 1600 and 1750.
